### PARISH WEEKLY CONTRIBUTION ENVELOPES



### ANNUAL HARVEST MASS OF THANKSGIVING

takes place on Sunday 14th October in Ashbourne Church at 11am. This annual celebration affords us all the opportunity to pause and give thanks for the blessings we have in life, to reflect on the sustainability of our 'common home', from which we sustain our families with food, and to think of, and respond to those without food. Bishop Paul Tighe, Rome will be the main celebrant at the 11am Mass. Originally from Navan, and now Secretary of the Pontifical Council for Culture, Bishop Paul joins our parish community to celebrate the month's memory Mass for the late Margaret Molloy.



A new European Data Protection law, the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") was introduced on 25th May 2018. This new law applies to any organisation, including our parish that manages and processes people's personal information. Our Diocese and Parish

Finance Committee continues to work on ways of ensuring that what we do with your information is compliant with this new law. It is a work in progress and over the next few months we will keep you informed through the parish newsletter as policies are put in place.

In order to comply with these new regulations we are now required to seek a **written** request from parishioners who require a copy of Baptismal Certs., Confirmation Certs., Letters of Freedom.

A valid ID i.e. Passport, Drivers Licence must now be presented when collecting these documents. For those aged 18 years and over these requests will have to be made by the person themselves.

All requests to register a child for Baptism must now be made by the parents of the child only.
