ALTAR LIST OF THE DEAD



The month of November is an occasion for us to continue the tradition of visiting the church and cemetery to pray quietly for our dead. Remembering our loved ones, family and friends during the month of November has always been seen as an act of charity to the faithful departed from those who still have the gift of life to help them attain their eternal rest.

Our prayers, particularly the offering of Mass, expresses our hope that God will free the person who has died from any burden of sin and prepare a place for them in heaven.

'From the beginning the Church has honoured the memory of the dead and offered prayers in suffrage for them, above all in the Eucharistic sacrifice, so that, thus purified, they may attain the beatific vision of God.' (Catechism of the Catholic Church n. 1032)

If you would like to add the names of those who have died to the Altar List of the Dead to be included in Masses in Ashbourne and Donaghmore throughout the month of November and every First Friday, please take an Altar List of the Dead Envelope (available at the back of the church) and return to the brown box at the back of the Church.

Some Things we can do in November:

- Attend an additional weekday Mass in remembrance of the dead and those who mourn.
- Visit the cemetery and pray for those we love.
- Go to confession (Saturdays 10.30am)
- Complete the Parish List of the Dead
- Say some family prayers together
- Abstain from alcohol (month's pledge to Sacred Heart of Jesus.)

All parents, siblings, grandparents & anyone else affected by the loss of a baby are very welcome to attend, regardless of whether the loss was recent or long ago.



A new European Data Protection law, the General Data Protection Regulation ("GDPR") was introduced on 25th May 2018. This new law applies to any organisation, including our parish that manages and processes people's personal information. Our

Diocese and Parish Finance Committee continues to work on ways of ensuring that what we do with your information is compliant with this new law. It is a work in progress and over the next few months we will keep you informed through the parish newsletter as policies are put in place.

In order to comply with these new regulations we are now required to seek a **written** request from parishioners who require a copy of Baptismal Certs., Confirmation Certs., Letters of Freedom. A valid ID i.e. Passport, Drivers Licence must now be presented when collecting these documents. For those aged 18 years and over these requests will have to be made by the person themselves. All requests to register a child for Baptism must now be made by the parents of the child only.
