

STANDING ORDER

It would greatly reduce expenses on the Parish if contributors could consider using a Standing Order instead of the weekly envelope to support the Parish. **Standing Orders are available on line www.ashbourneparish.ie**. This is a more secure way to contribute, it means you no longer need to remember a weekly envelope and it only needs to be set up once.

TAX REBATE

Ashbourne-Donaghmore Parish is a registered charity and the Revenue Commissioners allow tax relief on donations of over €250 per year made by parishioners to parish funds (this is the equivalent of €5 per week). We ask parishioners who are PAYE or Self-employed taxpayers, to allow the parish claim a refund from the Revenue Commissioners at no extra cost to you. This simply involves completing a form which will be sent to you and returning it to the parish office putting through the letterbox clearly marked.. We really urge parishioners to consider this option as it costs you nothing and benefits the Parish greatly.

OFFERTORY COLLECTION

This collection is taken up during the Offertory at all Masses on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation. It is now gathered at all Masses (Sunday and Weekday) when restrictions allow by way of Special Collection Boxes located at all Church doors. This assists with the day-to-day running costs of the Parish. This collection is not for the upkeep of the parish clergy.

WEEKLY ENVELOPE OR STANDING ORDER

This collection is used for the ongoing maintenance of Parish buildings and for Pastoral Care Services in the Parish as well as our Youth Ministry Outreach Programme.

OFFERINGS

Offering Sundays coincide with the different coloured envelopes in the boxes of envelopes. The offering envelopes are for the support of the Priests of the Parish. This allows the Parish to pay our priests' monthly wage—standardised by the Diocese of Meath—the running costs of their houses and related expenses.

SECOND COLLECTIONS

In 2014, the Parish Finance Committee standardised the number of collections taking place in any given month in order to alleviate the financial burden on people when they come to Church. These Sundays are set at the beginning of the year, for a designated project, cause or appeal. The necessity of these second collections is kept under yearly review and each month's appeal is clearly named on the envelope.
