Classes for the coming academic year will once again be held in the parish hall on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday afternoons and these will start the first week in October on the afternoon of Tuesday October 5th. Completed forms and the financial contribution towards the classes are now due. We thank Kay Churm and her team of teachers for their help in delivering this programme.

I would like to sincerely thank everybody who was so kind, thoughtful and generous during recent Silver Jubilee celebrations which coincided with my moving to take up a new role and ministry in the Diocese of Waterford and Lismore. I truly appreciate your well-wishing, cards and prayers!

While 'on loan' for the next three years in Waterford Diocese I will be based in the parish of St. Mary's, Irishtown, Clonmel as priest in residence. Gradual Reopening of our Churches

Ashbourne parish is gradually reopening and strengthening itself as it lives with covid. Up to 50 per cent of seats in our churches can now be filled. Face masks remain mandatory and parishioners are asked to continue to sanitise their hands often. We keep a respectful one meter distance from others and avoid congestion when leaving the church. The one-way system of coming up to holy communion remains in place with entry to your seat at the side aisle now possible. Holy communion continues by hand only. The sanitisation of the church building in between ceremonies also continues during this phase of transition. We thank the stewards for their work and everyone for their cooperation, patience and help with this transition. On 22 October 2021 all capacity limits at masses, weddings and funerals are due to be lifted.

Rite of Christian Initiation (RCIA)



Ashbourne parish is currently inviting any adults wishing to become catholic to contact them. Please email the parish office and an application form will be sent out and we will take it with you from there. The formal rite of Christian initiation will see candidates embark on a spiritual journey and involve catechesis where one learns about faith

in Jesus and living that faith in the Christian community. The seven month process of formation involves the reception of the sacraments of baptism, confession, communion and confirmation. We thank Brendan and Aine O Reilly for the work that they do in delivering the RCIA programme in Ashbourne and putting our parish on the catechetical map.

Thursday is Padre Pio's Feast Day

St. Padre Pio is a popular saint who received the stigmata of Christ and carried our Saviour's wounds for fifty years. He offered his daily sufferings in a loving way to Christ. He promoted prayer and built a hospital in San Giovanni and called it a 'home for the relief of suffering'. Mass for his feast is offered this Thursday at 10am. *Padre Pio, Pray for us.*

Anointing of the Sick Next Friday

As part of the 10am mass next Friday the Sacrament and anointing of the Sick will be available to parishioners. When someone who is sick or infirm comes forward for the sacrament they are anointed with the holy oil on their forehead and on the palm of their hand. For the anointing during the transition out of the pandemic cotton buds are used by Fr. Michael and Fr. Ciarán.

Parish Finance Committee Meeting

A meeting of the parish finance committee will take place on Thursday evening next (September 23rd) at 6.30pm in the boardroom of the Parish Hall. Fr. Michael looks forward to meeting all those involved in helping him look after financial affairs of our parish. At this meeting the parish accounts for 2020 will be presented and vision for the parish shared.
