

Pope Francis has appointed Fr Paul Connell, a priest of the Diocese of Meath who chairs the Irish bishops' Council for Education, as the new Bishop of Ardagh and Clonmacnois. He replaces Archbishop Francis Duffy, who left Ardagh & Clonmacnois when he was

appointed Archbishop of Tuam Diocese.

Parish Survey



Over 500 copies of the Parish Survey were distributed during March 2023 and responses were received back from 83 parishioners. The survey contained two sections. The first section dealt with Pastoral Concerns and the second section with Liturgical Concerns. This

account deals with the five questions posed under Liturgical Concerns. The survey asked for volunteers to help with the re -introduction of Mass servers and a few volunteers came forward. More than half of the respondents were happy with the current arrangements regarding cemetery devotions. Many and varied suggestions were offered regarding a parish retreat or mission.
