

#### **Update of Parish Funeral Booklet**

The Parish Funeral Booklet is being reprinted in the coming weeks and we are taking the opportunity to revise our funeral guidelines and let people know



how funerals are conducted and celebrated in our parish churches. The booklet contains options that families have with regard to readings from the bible and sacred music used in the catholic funeral rite. These readings from the Bible are currently being reprinted and the list of hymns used at funeral masses revised. The booklet was last printed eight years also. As a parish of the diocese of Meath we follow the guidelines laid down by the diocese.
