

Anointing with New Easter Oil

The sacrament of Anointing of the Sick will be part of the 10am daily Mass on Tuesday morning next.. This will be the first time the new oil of holy anointing will be used in our parish since it was blessed by Bishop Tom at the Chrism Mass on Wednesday of Holy Week. As followers of Jesus, we recall how Jesus was

close to the sick and, as Christians we always pray for those who are sick, infirm and in need of physical, mental or spiritual healing.

Visit of Pope Francis to Venice

Today Pope Francis travels on a daytrip to the iconic "floating city" of Venice. He will travel by motorboat along the canals, visit the Vatican pavilion at the Venice Biennale exhibition and offer Mass in St. Mark's Square. This is our Holy Father's first scheduled trip of the year. St. Mark is buried in Venice under the altar of the Cathedral bearing his name. At Sunday Masses during this Year B of the

liturgical calendar we are currently reading the gospel that Mark wrote. The feast of St. Mark was on Thursday last, April 25.







May Is Almost Upon Us



For 750 years May is a Month dedicated to Mary, the Mother of God. On Wednesday, May 1st, we celebrate May Day. It is a day when the May bush is put up, the dew on the grass welcomed and flowers placed around a picture or statue of Mary. As part of the 10am

Mass on Wednesday a crown is placed on our Lady's statue. There will be outdoor rosary at our Lady's Statue at 7.30pm that evening. As part of the 10am Mass in Donaghmore next Sunday there is a blessing of the countryside. The children in Senior Infants in our parish schools are being introduced to the Hail Mary and on the last weekend of May will join us at Sunday Mass to lead us in praying this great prayer of our Church.

Bus Escorts are required to work on School Transport - bus/ taxisupervising pupils whilst travelling to and from St. Michael's School, Clonsilla. St. Michael's School caters for pupils ages 5 - 18 years who on psychological testing are found to be functioning within the level of Mild General Learning Disability. Previous experience working with children desirable. Garda vetting will be required. Hours of work may vary slightly but in general 7.30 a.m. - 9.15 a.m. and 3.00 p.m. - 5.00 p.m. for the Primary School Calendar Year. This particular Bus Escort Position is for Baltrasna, Ashbourne and Dussink, Finglas route. Please telephone

Dates and Times of This Year's Cemetery Devotions



The Annual Blessing of Graves will take place in our parish in just over a month's time. Mass for those interred both in Ashbourne Church Cemetery and Killegland Cemetery will take place in Ashbourne Church on Saturday June 1st at 7pm. The blessing

of the graves will take place immediately afterwards at 7.45pm. The graves in Killegland Cemetery will be blessed at 8.15pm that same evening. On the following Saturday evening of June 8th the 7pm Vigil Mass will be offered for those interred in St. Declan's Cemetery with blessing of the graves afterwards at 8.30pm. The graves in Donaghmore will be blessed at 10.45am following the Sunday morning Mass of June 2nd in Donaghmore church. Devotions in Greenogue will follow at 11.30am.

Parish Meetings in the Coming Weeks

The next meeting of the Parish Pastoral Assembly will take place on Tuesday evening May 7th at 7pm in the Parish Centre. This meeting will continue to look at building up parish resources for parents preparing children for Holy Communion. It will also reflect on enhancing our faith community's celebration of Pentecost and Corpus Christi. The priests of the parish will meet with the parishioners of the faith community of Donaghmore on Tuesday evening May 21st at 7pm in the Church. We are looking at improving storage for the church, reviewing how Lent and Easter went and finalising Cemetery Devotions for the June Bank Holiday weekend. On Tuesday evening May 7th at 5.30pm the Parish Finance

Committee will meet in the Parish Centre. It is hoped that at this meeting the parish will approve last year's accounts and will move closer towards making a decision on the future of the Old National School.
